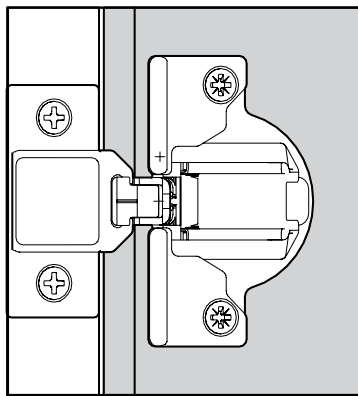

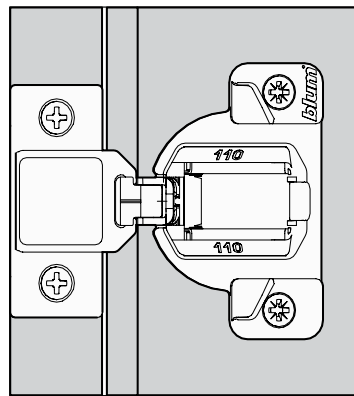

COMPACT 31

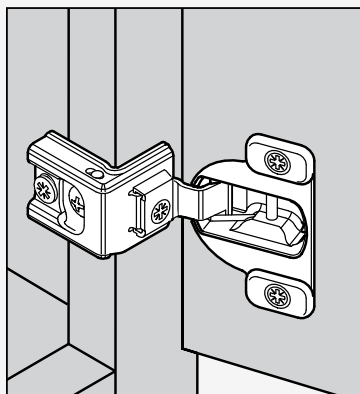


COMPACT 33



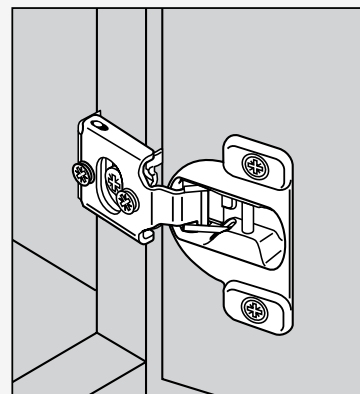
Current Hinges

OR

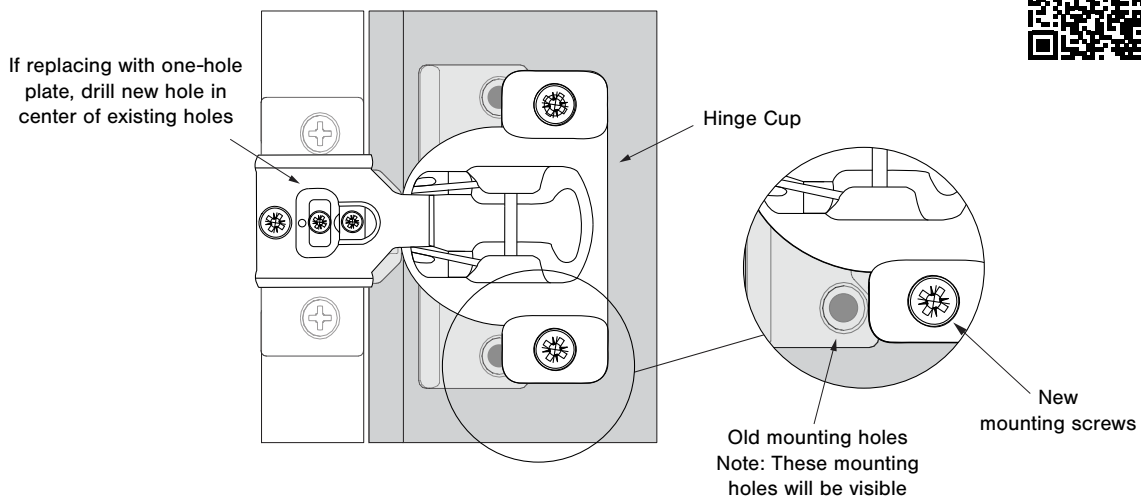
COMPACT 38N

COMPACT 31 Replacement

When replacing a COMPACT 31, the direction of the hinge cup is rotated, and the previous mounting holes will still be visible as shown below.

- For the frame, if you have a two-hole mounting plate, you will need **#8 x 3/4 trusshead screws**
- For the hinge cup, you will need **#6 x 5/8 wood screws**

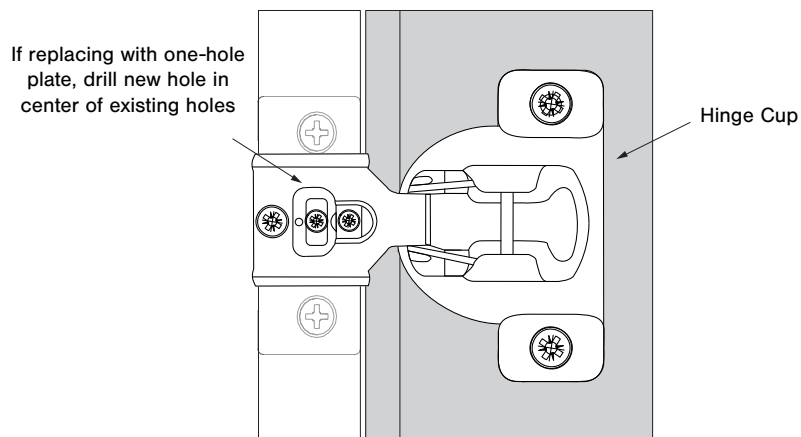

COMPACT 33 Replacement

When replacing a COMPACT 33, the hinge cup can be screwed into existing holes on the door.

- For the frame, if you have a two-hole mounting plate, you will need **#8 x 3/4 trusshead screws**
- For the hinge cup, you can use existing screws
